



Basketball GIRLS League Rules

\$	Referee Fees	\$
6 th – 12 th grade leagues - \$25/team – 2 referees per game Combined 5 th /6 th grade league - \$20/team – 2 referees per game		

Girls - Grades 6 – 12

- Ball size
 - 28.5 for grade 7-12
- Basket height
 - All play on regulation 10' baskets
- Press
 - For 6th-12th grade leagues, full court press allowed by any team not ahead by 15 or more points.
 - For combined 5th/6th grade leagues, full-court press is only allowed in the 4th quarter by a team not winning by 15 or more points.
- Game time
 - Grades 5th/6th, 6th-10th, Four (4) six (6) minute stop and go quarters.
 - Grades 11th/12th, Four (4) eight (8) minute stop and go quarters.
 - Three (3) minute overtime as necessary.
 - Three (3) minute half time.
- Time outs
 - Five (5) per game, three (3) one minute and two (2) thirty (30) second.
 - Each team receives one (1) additional time out for overtime.
- Free throw line
 - All leagues, grades 5th-12th, use regulation fifteen (15) feet.
 - No player may enter the lane until the ball touches the backboard or rim.
 - The first spot available in the free throw lane will be the second (2nd) box.
- Defense
 - Coaches can play any half court defense.
- Miscellaneous
 - Players can play up in age level but not down. No player is permitted to play on more than one team per grade level.
 - Players may be added to the roster up until the fifth (5th) game of the season. No additional players may be added after that time.
 - No jewelry may be worn including but not limited to earrings, face paint or hair paint.
 - Should a team forfeit a tournament championship game, no awards will be given to that team for 2nd place.

- Home team is official scorebook.
- A team may start, play and finish a game with only four players. There is a 10 minute grace period from the scheduled start time for a team to have 10 players. However, if a team has 5 players, the game must start at the scheduled time.
- If a player receives a technical foul during a game for unsportsmanlike conduct or excessive foul language, the player is ineligible to play for the remainder of that game.
