



Basketball League Rules

\$25/team/game – 2 referees per game		

Men's Leagues

- Ball size
 - 29.5
- Basket height
 - Regulation 10' baskets. NO hanging on the rim at any time.
- Press
 - Press allowed at any time.
- Game time
 - Two (2) twenty minute running halves. Clock is stop and go final one (1) minute of game unless there is a 15 point lead.
 - Two (2) minute overtime as necessary.
 - Three (3) minute half time.
- Time outs
 - Five (5) per game, three (3) one minute and two (2) thirty (30) second.
 - Each team receives one (1) additional time out for overtime.
- Free throw line
 - Regulation fifteen (15) feet.
 - No player may enter the lane until the ball touches the backboard or rim.
 - Effective with the fall session, 2010, players may enter the lane after the release of the ball by the shooter. The shooter may not enter the lane until the ball hits the backboard or rim.
- Defense
 - Coaches can play any half court defense.
- Miscellaneous
 - No player is permitted to play on more than one team per level.
 - Players may be added to the roster up until the fifth (5th) game of the season. No additional players may be added after that time.
 - No jewelry may be worn including but not limited to earrings, face paint or hair paint.
 - A team may start, play and finish a game with only four players. There is a 10 minute grace period from the scheduled game starting time for a team to have five players. However, if a team has 5 players, the game must be started at the scheduled time.
 - Home team is official scorebook.

- If a player receives a technical foul during a game for unsportsmanlike conduct or excessive foul language, the player is ineligible to play for the remainder of that game.
