



Facility Rules and League Regulations

Nothin' but Net Sports Complex is committed to providing the community a first class facility with first class service to athletes and spectators of all ages. We strive to facilitate an exciting environment where good sportsmanship and good competition are the rule and not the exception. We work hard to be the place where people of all ages participate in healthy activities that assist them in becoming better people both physically and mentally.

Facility rules

- No running in common areas (including but not limited to the concession area, restrooms and any area that is not a court).
- No use of foul language will be tolerated.
- No cleats or roller shoes (ex. Heelys) of any type are permitted.
- Nothin' but Net (NbN) management reserves the right to refuse admittance to anyone.
- Nothin' but Net management reserves the right to remove anyone from the premises.
- No parking in fire lane or any parking spot that is not clearly marked. This will result in a parking ticket or towing of your vehicle. All tickets and towing fees are the responsibility of the vehicle owner.
- Fighting is not tolerated.
- There is a spectator charge to the facility. Please see the website or front gate for current entrance fees.

Coaches responsibilities

- It is your responsibility to set a good example for the participants and spectators of not only your team but other teams that are playing at NbN. Please keep in mind, you are a role model. Coaches must maintain control of their players and spectators.
 - Roster – must be legible and completed prior to the start of the first game. First and last names of the players are required. Additions can be made up to the fifth (5th) game of the session.
 - Release of liability waivers – the coach is responsible to have parents/players sign the waiver forms. No one will be permitted to play or participate in any activity at Nothin' but Net without signing a waiver form. If the parent/guardian or participant refuses to sign the waiver form, Nothin' but Net reserves the right to refuse services or to allow participation in activity or league.
 - Schedules – coaches must periodically check the website for any changes or updates and communicate them to their parents. It is not the responsibility or fault of NbN if there is a schedule change and the players/parents have not been informed.
 - Fees – all monies must be paid in full prior to the start of the first game, if payment in full is not received prior to the first game the team will forfeit. It is the coaches' responsibility to collect all monies and submit in full to NbN. **No individual player payment will be accepted.**
 - All coaches must be listed on the roster. Only those coaches listed will be permitted on the sideline or bench. All coaches must show their coaches pass for the current season to be admitted free. **ONLY 2 coaches' passes will be given to each team. We are not responsible for lost or stolen passes. ONLY 2 COACHES PER TEAM ADMITTED FREE.**
 - It is the coaches' responsibility to be aware of the Ohio High School Athletic Association (OHSAA) and Federation rules and abide by them.
 - Only **ONE** coach will be permitted to stand during the game at any level and must stay on their half of the court at all times. Coaches are not permitted on the court during games (exception for 1st/2nd grade C level).
 - NbN reserves the right to move any team from one level of competition to another.
 - It is your responsibility to coach your players, not call the game. Please respect our referees.

Players/Parents

- Players are only permitted to play up in their respective age league. No player is permitted to play in a lower age division.
- Players are not permitted to play in multiple divisions or teams in their respective age league. Example, a player cannot play in the A division in the 1st and 2nd grade league and also in the B division in the 1st and 2nd grade league. Any team in violation of this rule will forfeit the game. A player cannot play on more than one (1) team in their age level.
- No jewelry of any kind may be worn during games, including but not limited to earrings, necklaces, bracelets, etc. Hair and face paint are not permitted.
- Players with long hair are requested to use elastic hair bands when tying hair up.
- Players who wear prescription glasses are requested to wear sports goggles or elastic bands.
- Players and parents are required to sign a code of conduct form. Refusal to sign the code of conduct form from the player or parent will result in the player not being eligible to play in the league.

Forfeit/Reschedule policy

- Forfeits are always discouraged. If in the event that a team has to forfeit, your \$50 fee will not be refunded to you at the end of the season.
- Reschedules are always discouraged. It is the policy of NbN to work around any conflict that is provided to us **PRIOR** to setting the season schedule. If a reschedule is requested from a team, your \$50 fee will not be refunded to you at the end of the season. Each additional reschedule will result in a \$50 fee to be paid prior to the reschedule. Reschedules must be accepted by the opposing team.
- It is the responsibility of the coach/captain to contact NbN directly for reimbursement of their forfeit/reschedule fee.

Protests

- A protest on the court must be made prior to the end of the game to the officials with the exception of player eligibility. Player eligibility must be verified prior to the start of the 3rd quarter. If it is found that a non-eligible player is playing, the game will immediately be forfeited by that team. All protests must be made by a coach listed on the teams roster.

Officials

- Each team is responsible to pay the officials prior to the start of the game.
- We expect our officials to act in a courteous and professional manner, however, we do not expect them to take any form of abuse.
- Any feedback or concerns regarding officials should be made in writing to the management of NbN.

Uniforms and Equipment

- Numbered shirts/jerseys are required. It is highly recommended that numbers are on both the front and back.
- All players on the same team must wear the same color shirt/jersey.
- NbN does not provide volleyballs, basketballs or futsal balls for the leagues. It is each team's responsibility to bring their own balls to all services offered at NbN.

Registration

- A non-refundable deposit in the amount of \$50 is required along with your registration form to hold a spot for your team. In the event that your team decides to withdraw, your deposit is forfeited.
- Teams are accepted on a first come first serve basis.

Refunds

- No refunds are given under any circumstance.

Lost and Found

- NbN is not responsible for lost or stolen items. We make every effort to contact the owner of an item if their name or phone number is on the item. We hold items for up to two (2) weeks and will donate or discard them after that time.

Inclement Weather

- NbN reserves the right to cancel games or practices due to weather conditions.
- A coach may choose to cancel a practice at his/her discretion without notifying NbN. Parents/players should contact their coach for verification.
- In the event of inclement weather, NbN will post on their website (www.nbnsportscomplex.com) at least one hour prior to game time that games are either postponed or cancelled.
- NbN will also update the main line (513) 528-1000 indicating a postponement or cancellation of games.
- It is the responsibility of the coaches and players/parents to check the website and or call the main line to get the inclement weather update.
- In the event that the management decides to close the facility due to inclement weather, the activities scheduled for that night will be rescheduled subject to availability. In the event that a coach, club or other organization decides to cancel their activity scheduled at the facility and the facility is still open, we will not reschedule that activity.

Facility and League Penalties

- NO ONE is permitted to coach from the spectator sidelines.
- **FIGHTING WILL NOT BE TOLERATED** on the premises of NbN. Any person ejected for fighting will be banned from the league. Authorities will also be notified.
- A player or coach that is ejected during or after a game by a referee will automatically be suspended from the current game and the next game in the season.
- A player or coach that has accumulated three (3) ejections during a season will be banned from participation in any service offered by NbN.
- If it is found that a player is playing on more than one (1) team in the same age level at NbN, the team will be made to forfeit the game played.
